

WCL Choate Youth Festival Rules

US Lacrosse/CONNYS rules will apply (except for WCL Festival specific team division rules)

A. US Lacrosse/CONNYS rules will apply (except for WCL Festival specific team division rules)

B. All substitutions will be on the "fly" (no horns)

C. Team divisions are: U-13 and U-15

(we strongly suggest bringing "A" team caliber players)

D. Games will be two (2) twenty minutes halves with a 5 min intermission

E. There will be no timeserving penalties (EMO situations).

Teams will always play at full strength. The team that was fouled will be awarded a ten (10) yard fast break. If a player commits a personal or malicious foul that person will be asked to sit out and will be substituted for. Again, teams will play all even.

F. There will be no time outs

G. Scores will not be kept.

H. Exemplary conduct by coaches and sideline parents is paramount.

I. Our entire campus is "SMOKE FREE"

J. Fighting will result in "instant expulsion" from the game and that player will not be allowed to play the remainder of the day

Foul language, baiting or taunting will not be tolerated. Any player committing this act will be ejected for the remainder of that game and the next game

L. Important Important Important Divisions are U-13 and U-15

All coaches must send in their team's roster (player's name, age, DOB and grade) along with each player's waiver that has been signed by their parent or guardian. These documents must arrive in a single envelope and be sent to the Festival director's address no later than April 1, 2012. If these items are not received, that team or player will not be allowed to participate in the Festival.

The Choate Youth Lacrosse Festival has become a well-respected, well-attended, great pre-season event. Lots of student athletes get valuable playing time, and coaches can hone their skills as the fast approaching season nears. There are certainly going to be many requests to enter, so please return the attached application form immediately. No program will be confirmed until their entry form and fee have been received and accepted. Once the field of teams has been established, a confirmation letter along with a schedule and directions will be e-mailed to you.
